

## The 2023 Pay for Quality Program

The Meridian Medicaid Plan (Meridian) Pay for Quality (P4Q) Program is a pay-for-performance incentive program for our contracted providers. We reward our partners in care for delivering quality preventive healthcare services such as immunizations, well-child visits, and prenatal care to members.
