Reducing hypertension with healthy foods



Meridian's Food is Medicine pilot program, in partnership with the Greater Chicago Food Depository, is a new way we're supporting members with high blood pressure. A cohort of members who live in south Chicago will be selected for the pilot program and receive heart-healthy meals and food each week. They will also be connected to:

- Education from a registered dietitian on grocery shopping and meal prep
- One-on-one care management support
- Continued blood pressure monitoring

For billing questions, contact your assigned Provider Engagement Administrator or representative. If your practice doesn't have an assigned representative, please complete our <u>intake form</u>.

In case you missed it

- Meridian providers can now use <u>Availity</u> to verify member eligibility, submit and check claims, manage authorizations and submit medical record documentation to close HEDIS® care gaps.
- The Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) released a <u>new handbook for Community-Based Behavioral Services providers</u>.
- Has your organization completed revalidation with HFS? If not, avoid being disenrolled from the Medicaid program by reviewing our <u>provider notice</u> and ensuring your contact information is accurate in <u>IMPACT</u>.
- Illinois recently launched a new public portal called <u>BEACON</u> (Behavioral Health Care and Ongoing Navigation), which centralizes resources for Illinois youth and families seeking mental health services. Review <u>frequently asked questions</u> about BEACON to learn more.
