where to go to get the *right* care

At Meridian, you're covered for the care you need. Here's how you can choose where to go for care services, depending on the situation.



For your regular medical needs, visit your primary care provider (PCP). This includes annual checkups, flu vaccines, routine tests, and more.





When your PCP isn't available but you need to be treated quickly, go to urgent care.

They can treat earaches, mild fever, sprains or strains, and more.



For other non-emergency health issues, Meridian has a 24/7 Nurse Advice Line.

Call toll-free at <u>866-606-3700</u> (TTY: <u>711</u>). Trained nurses can answer your health questions and help you decide if you should see your PCP.

If you have an injury or illness that could be life-threatening, seek emergency care at the nearest hospital. This includes head or eye injuries, chest pain, broken bones, bleeding that won't stop, and gun or knife wounds. You should also call your PCP after going to the emergency room. Your PCP can help you get the follow-up care you need.

cervical cancer: know your risk.


<u>More than 90% of cervical cancers</u> are caused by HPV. But there are other risk factors too. These include:

- Family history
- HIV or a weakened immune system
- Long-term use of birth control pills

learn the risk factors

These risk factors don't mean you will get cervical cancer. Be aware of your risk factors and pay attention to your body. See your provider if you notice unusual bleeding or pain in your pelvic area. It's also important to tell your provider about any risk factors. Together, you can watch for early signs of cervical cancer and make regular Pap tests part of your care. You can get rewarded when you complete a screening.

If you have preteens, **prevention is key**. They may be the right age to begin the HPV vaccine series. Watch this video to learn more.

find a *telehealth* provider.

Your Meridian benefits cover telehealth services. These appointments can be completed on a phone, computer, or tablet. Telehealth appointments can be useful for services like:

- Caring for a cold or earache
- Monitoring a chronic condition
- Getting medication refills
- Talking to a behavioral health provider

If you want to see an in-network provider virtually, click on the Find a Provider tool. Then search for in-network providers who offer telehealth services. Or call your provider and ask if telehealth services are available through their office.

vaccines for all Illinois residents

If you didn't get the recommended fall and winter vaccines yet, it's not too late. Vaccines can protect you from the flu, COVID-19, and/or RSV. And there are many places you can go to get vaccines at no cost.

- Your local pharmacy
- Your provider's office
- Many community events we participate in
- Public Health Departments, Federally Qualified Health Centers, and vaccine clinics

Use the Illinois Department of Public Health's <u>Vaccine Locator</u> to find sites in your area that offer no-cost vaccines through the Adult Immunization and Vaccines for Children programs.

Rewards and health actions are dependent on eligibility for specific activities, which will vary by individual. Members may not qualify for all health activities. The date of service to redeem a reward must be in the current plan year. Rewards can be redeemed up to 30 days following the conclusion of the program period.
