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Introducing Wellcare By Meridian



Effective **January 1**, Wellcare Meridian Dual Align (HMO D-SNP) combines Medicaid and Medicare Advantage benefits into one plan. What you need to know:

- The Meridian Medicare-Medicaid Plan (MMP) sunsets on **December 31**
- Current Meridian MMP members will automatically be enrolled in the Wellcare By Meridian D-SNP.
- The majority of providers contracted with Meridian MMP and Wellcare Medicare Advantage plans were mailed amendments with the Wellcare by Meridian D-SNP requirements. The amendment

automatically becomes effective on **January 1, 2026**, unless the provider contacted Meridian to opt out.





 Due to a <u>shortage of diabetic testing supplies</u> on the preferred drug list (PDL), HFS is temporarily removing prior authorization requirements for non-preferred brands.
