Prenatal Care (PPC)

Did you know?

Prenatal care should start in the first trimester. When recommending prenatal vitamins, make sure the prescription has at least 600 micrograms of folic acid.*

What should appear in the medical record?

- A basic obstetric exam that includes listening for fetal heart tones
 - Pelvic exam indicating findings
 - Measurement of fundus height
 - Diagnosis of pregnancy
- Evidence that a prenatal care visit **AND** prenatal care procedure was performed, such as:
 - Screening test in the form of an obstetric panel (e.g., hematocrit, platelet count, rubella antibody)
 - TORCH antibody panel
 - Ultrasound of a pregnant uterus

How can you make the most of the visit?

The first prenatal care visit is an opportune time to provide other services that may be necessary, including:

- - Chlamydia screening
 - If the member is under 21 years of age, prenatal visits can also qualify as adolescent well-care visits. Be sure to include all of the following in the medical record:
- A health and developmental history (physical and mental)
- A physical exam
- Health education/Anticipatory guidance

Scheduling Postpartum Care

When should the Postpartum Visit be scheduled?

- Appointments for postpartum care should be scheduled at the 38-week prenatal visit.
- Appointments for postpartum care may be scheduled in the hospital prior to discharge if an appointment was not scheduled during the 38-week prenatal visit.

When should postpartum care occur?

Postpartum care should occur 7-84 days after delivery.

What should appear in the medical record?

- A note indicating the date of the visit and at least one of the following:
- Pelvic exam
- Evaluation of weight, blood pressure, breasts, and abdomen
- Notation of "postpartum care"

Making the most of the visit

If the member is under 21 years of age, postpartum visits can also qualify as adolescent well-care visits.

- Be sure to include all of the following in the medical record:
- A health and developmental history (physical and mental)
- A physical exam
- Health education/Anticipatory guidance
