# Important tests and exams to help manage diabetes

#### **Blood tests\***

• Before-meal blood sugars: 70-130 mg/dL

Postmeal (≈2.0 hours) blood sugars: <180 mg/dL</li>

• A1C: <7%

- Quarterly if treatment changes or not at goal

- At least 2 times a year if stable at goal

- · Lipid profile
  - Yearly
  - LDL ("bad" cholesterol): <100 mg/dL</p>
  - Triglycerides: <150 mg/dL</li>
  - HDL ("good" cholesterol):
    - >40 mg/dL for males
    - >50 mg/dL for females

#### **Urine tests\***

- Microalbuminuria: <30 μg/mg creatinine</li>
  - Yearly
- Urinalysis
  - Ketones, protein, sediment



### Eye exam\*

- Dilated eye exam
  - Yearly

#### Other tests\* (if indicated)

- Thyroid-stimulating hormone
- Electrocardiogram
- Dental exam

## **Blood pressure\***

 Blood pressure: <130/80 mmHg each diabetes visit

#### Foot exams\*

- Visual exam
  - Each diabetes visit
- Comprehensive foot exam
  - At least yearly (more often in patients with high-risk foot conditions)

\*Individual goals may be different
